Volunteers choose how they want to be involved based on their interests, skills and schedule. Be a part of our family through volunteering!

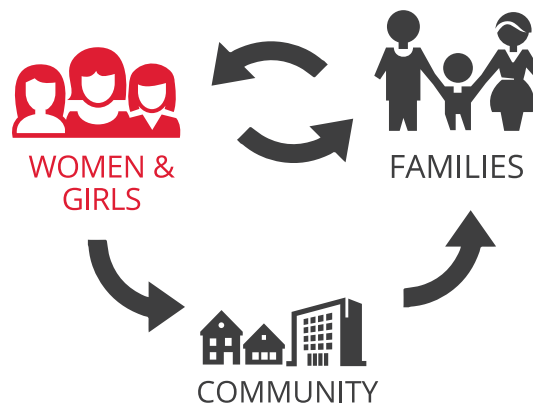
